Communion at the "Selection Point" A Message of Repentance, Redemption & Hope By Dr. Howard Morgan







The top picture is an actual "selection" in progress at Birkenau. Below it, is a photo taken during a Communion at the "Selection Point" in 2008. I am holding two pieces of barbed wire from the camp fence put together and given to me by Pastor Werner Oder, whose father was a Nazi SS mass murderer. At the exact moment that we raised up this unique symbol of both Holocaust and Hope, declaring that only the redemption purchased by Messiah's death on the Cross can turn Holocaust into Hope, a cross appeared in the sky.

Unleashed Prejudice

The Holocaust, the systematic murder of 6 million European Jews, is one of the most catastrophic periods of genocide and dehumanization in history. Amazingly there are groups today that even deny the Holocaust ever happened. The Holocaust cannot be erased from history nor dismissed as the work of a handful of irrational mad men.

Each progressive act of Nazi persecution and cruelty toward the Jews evolved according to a perverse logic, facilitated in large part because the rest of the world ignored the plight of the Jews, refusing to provide them sanctuary and choosing to remain silent. To label the perpetrators as irrational ignores the evolution of their ideology and political prowess, the extent of the complex organizational involvement required and the vast participation which almost made it possible for Hitler's Final Solution to the Jewish Problem, the complete extermination of the European Jews, to succeed. Simply put, Hitler and his henchmen could never have succeeded without assistance from tens of thousands of planners, participants and collaborators, as well as the apathetic acquiescence of other nations.

The only way to prevent another Holocaust is to understand what motivated the Nazis to use their knowledge, skill and technology for genocidal purposes. We must to come to grips with the horrors created by unleashed lust for power, vicious prejudice, heartless apathy and callous indifference.

It's Called Anti-Semitism

Anti-Semitism is the hatred and hostility toward or discrimination against Jews as a religious group or race. It takes many different forms including religious teachings proclaiming God's rejection of the Jews because they did not accept Jesus as their Messiah. Maintaining their own unique religion and culture, the Jewish people were victimized by various kinds of prejudicial or stereotypical beliefs and practices.

History of Hatred

The Jewish people have lived under a long history of prejudice and persecution that ebbed and flowed throughout their history. At various times and in different places they were subjected to diverse kinds of horrific treatment. These ranged from the more benign kinds of discrimination to the horrific pogroms (government sponsored massacres) and national expulsions (i.e. Spain in 1492). The foundation for this persecution was spawned by anti-Semitic doctrines taught by the Christian Church, both Catholic and Protestant.

While the Enlightenment and the French Revolution brought new religious freedom to Europe in the 18th century, it did not reduce anti-Semitism and Jews continued to be treated as outsiders. In the 19th century, discrimination continued and in some places violently intensified. So-called "scientific racism" emerged, which based hostility to the Jews on their supposed biological characteristics and replaced religion as the primary basis for anti-Semitism. Continuing into the 20th century, the economic and political dislocations caused by World War I intensified prejudice

against the Jewish people and racist anti-Semitism flourished in Nazi Germany fueling the Holocaust.

The Jews – Key to the Return of Jesus

Throughout history, anti-Semitism has been more than a religious, social, economic or political phenomenon. It is a strategy inspired by demonic spirits that not only seek to hurt or kill Jews, but to actually prevent the second coming of Jesus (Yeshua) the Messiah. The Jewish people are Satan's target not simply because they are Jews but because they hold a pivotal place in **God's plan to return Messiah** to the earth (Zech. 12:10-11, 14:4; Matt. 23:39; Rom. 11:15). We must understand this in order to recognize and effectively expose the sources of anti-Semitism and, as God gives us the abilities, stand together against its activities and eradicate its effects.

Let me explain this a little further for you. The ultimate goal of the demons that inspire anti-Semitism is always the same, the destruction of the Jewish people. Why? Because Satan understands that the Jewish people are central to God's plan for the second coming of Jesus. In Matthew 23:39, Jesus told the Jews that they would not **see Him** again until they **said to Him**, "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord." Please pay close attention to the fact that the **Saying** precedes the **seeing**. In other words, the Jews who rejected Jesus must receive Him. They must call for Him to return.

In Acts 3:21, Peter declares that Jesus "must remain in heaven until the time for the restoration of all the things the prophets proclaimed." The prophets declared many things about the Jewish people, including their regathering to the land of Israel. The prophet Zechariah said that when God pours out on the Jewish people the "Spirit of grace and of supplication," they will "look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn..." (Zech. 12:10). On that great national day of revelation, the Jewish people will call Jesus back from heaven.

I believe that the apostle Paul affirms this in Romans 11:15: "For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?" Since we know from verse 1 of this chapter that God has not rejected the Jewish people, the rejection Paul speaks of here is the Jewish rejection of Jesus. Dr. David Stern's "Complete Jewish Bible" translates it: "For if their casting Yeshua aside means reconciliation for the world, what will their accepting him mean? It will be life from the dead!" Their rejection of Jesus means the reconciliation of the world. Their acceptance of Jesus will mean "life from the dead." I personally do not believe this is referring to worldwide revival. I believe this is referring to the actual resurrection of the dead. We know from 1 Cor. 15:51-52 and 1 Thes. 4:16-18, that this resurrection takes place when the Messiah returns. We also know that His return means the imprisonment, and eventual destruction of the devil and all of his work (Rev. 20:1-7).

Satan also knows this plan and has tried and will continue trying to stop the words of the prophets from being fulfilled. If he can accomplish this, then according to Acts 3:21, Jesus will remain in Heaven. Because the Jewish people hold this central place in God's plan for the return of their King, they are Satan's specific target. Satan's plan is simple. If he can destroy the Jews by

assimilation or death – (he prefers death so there is no possible way of their being restored), he can stop the words of the prophets from being fulfilled and thereby prevent Jesus from returning.

This explains why there have been so many different times when the Jewish people were persecuted or killed. Satan wanted them to lose their identity as Jews or lose their lives so that there would be no one to fulfill the words of the prophets. The Nazi's obsession with murdering Jews was Satan's attempt at preventing the return of Jesus. The same spirit that inspired them is now operating under the guise of fundamentalist Islam. What it failed to do in the Holocaust, it is now trying to do with a "Jihad" or "Holy War." The president of Iran's tirades about destroying Israel in a nuclear holocaust must be taken seriously. He is operating in the same demonic spirit as Hitler.

As we understand the demonic aspects of this battle, we must be very diligent to keep our "armor" on and make use of our many spiritual weapons (Eph. 6:11-18, 2 Cor. 10:4, 5). We should never be ignorant of the enemy's devices (2 Cor. 2:11), but always remember that he is a defeated foe (Col. 2:15) and we fight this battle far above him, seated with Jesus in heavenly places (Eph. 1:20-22, 2:15).

God Warns the Church

Understanding that anti-Semitism is a demonic strategy to prevent the return of Jesus, we can understand why God gave us such a strong warning about not allowing it into our hearts.

"But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive, were grafted in among them and became partaker with them of the rich root of the olive tree, do not be arrogant toward the branches; but if you are arrogant, remember that it is not you who supports the root, but the root supports you. You will say then, 'Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in.' Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith. Do not be conceited, but fear; for if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare you, either. Behold then the kindness and severity of God; to those who fell, severity, but to you, God's kindness, if you continue in His kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off."

Romans 11:17-22 (NASB)

In this extremely important passage of Scripture, Paul declares that God considers arrogance toward the Jewish people (the natural branches) to be a very grievous sin. So heinous is this sin in the sight of God that those who are guilty of it will experience the **severity of God's judgment** and actually be **cut off** from the very source of their spiritual life, the roots of the Olive Tree. Paul did not originate this term. He is referencing the many times the expression "cut off" is used in the Hebrew Bible. He is also drawing from his background as a Rabbi because the traditional understanding of this expression meant premature death. Everyone who reads this can understand the simplicity of the analogy. Any branch removed from a tree no longer receives the nourishment from the roots of that tree and it dies.

Amazingly, church leaders disobeyed this apostolic warning and became arrogant toward the Jewish people. Their anti-Semitism brought the judgment of God. The Church was **cut off** from

her roots in Israel's Olive Tree. She no longer received the spiritual life that flows from those "rich (literally *oily* or *anointed*) roots."

History shows the results of being **cut off**. We witness a three-fold demonic strategy of Greek philosophy, (intellectualism and humanism replacing revelation), Roman forms of government (emperors replacing servants), and pagan religious beliefs (for example, Easter replacing Passover). This strategy created various unbiblical doctrines, dogmas, beliefs and practices which transformed the original authentic apostolic and prophetic Holy Spirit filled Body of Christ into a new institutionalized religion called Christianity. What started in the spirit was now in the flesh (Gal. 3:3).

In addition, this new religion was inspired by the enemy to maintain an adversarial and persecutorial relationship with the Jewish people thereby preventing God's ancient people from receiving a true testimony of who Jesus really is and what He has really done. In other words, anti-Semitism not only cut off the Church from her life-giving roots, it also perverted the Church's relationship to the Jewish people. Instead of proclaiming a loving testimony of redemption toward the Jewish people and flowing in Holy Spirit empowered supernatural life that could provoke natural Israel to spiritual jealousy, Christianity was filled with demonic doctrines that taught contempt and hatred for the Jewish people, and inspired horrific acts of persecution.

Satan had created a masterpiece. He cut the Church off from her roots and perverted her relationship with the natural branches. Instead of provoking the Jews to faith in Jesus, the Church did the exact opposite. Through its demonically inspired teachings of contempt for the Jews and its legacy of hatred and persecutions, the Church continually provoked the Jewish people to a deeply felt hostility and antagonism towards Jesus that remains to this day. In one of the great ironic tragedies of history, the Church was now working with the devil and opposing God's plan for the return of her own Lord.

Tragically anti-Semitism remains in the Church today. Replacement theology and other virulent anti-Jewish, anti-Israel doctrines are endemic throughout Christianity. All of it must be confronted and removed. This will happen as believers from around the world repent for the Church's historic collusion with the spirit of anti-Semitism and renounce any present connection to it. The fruit of that repentance will be a restoration of the Church to her Biblical relationship and responsibility to the Jewish people.

The motive and goal of the demonic spirit of anti-Semitism has not changed. Only the strategies change. In Nazi Germany, it expressed itself using racial ideology. In radical Islam, it uses religious beliefs and political goals. Do not be naïve. This spirit not only seeks the destruction of the "Zionist entity illegitimately created by western infidels on Muslim land," but the destruction of the "Saturday people" and the "Sunday people" who, as non-Muslims, are considered infidels and therefore worthy of death. This satanic spirit seeks to rule the world. It will not! The God of Israel will!

The Nazi's Plan to Eradicate the Jewish People

One of the most horrific implementations of Satan's strategy took place during the Holocaust. Mixing racist political ideology with strong occultic beliefs, the Nazis were demonically inspired to attempt the systematic murder all of the **11 Million** Jewish men, women and children of Europe, and if they had won the war, all the Jews in the world. When mobile death squads (einsatzgruppen) proved ineffective, they created a plan to systematically identify the Jews and then assemble them in walled-off sections of cities called ghettos. Jews were then transported in railroad cattle cars to death camps, where they would be selected for immediate death in the gas chambers or worked to death as starved slave labor.

Deception and Delusion

Just as the devil is a master of lies and deception, convincing people of one thing when the exact opposite is the truth - and doing so in amazingly subtle ways - so were the Nazis. They were proficient liars and deceivers, capable of great subtlety when they desired to hide their true intentions. Although they boldly proclaimed their desires to make Europe *Judenrein* - **free of Jews** - they kept the exact method of mass extermination a closely guarded secret. The SS officers and soldiers who were to carry out the murders were carefully chosen for their jobs and all of them were sworn to secrecy.

The Nazis used coded language in all their communications. As an example, they often used the word "action" to mean that mass murder was to happen or had already been completed. They were also able to convince entire Jewish communities that they were merely being resettled to better, safer conditions. In order to make this transition as easy as possible, the Jews were encouraged to take their valuables and personal items with them. This was only to make the job of robbing them easier. Sometimes the Nazis even convinced the Jews to buy tickets for the train ride.

Auschwitz and the Death Camps

The first of the death camps was located just outside the Polish town of Oswiecim. The Nazis gave it the infamous German name, Auschwitz (pronounced *Ow-shh-vitz*). At Auschwitz, originally a Polish army camp, the Nazis perfected the **science of mass murder**. After perfecting this process, they built a second much larger death factory named Birkenau or Auschwitz II, about two miles away. Birkenau had four massive underground **gas chambers**, each capable of killing 2,000 people in about 20 minutes. To minimize panic the Nazis installed fake shower heads in the ceiling, telling their victims that they were only going to take showers. Then they dropped **cyanide pellets** into these airtight rooms from openings in the ceilings. Upon contact with air the pellets created deadly fumes. Jewish workers removed the corpses, shaved their heads (the hair was used for making blankets and stuffing mattresses) and removed gold from their teeth. Located next to the gas chambers were **huge crematoriums** with dozens of specially designed ovens. Each one could, on average, cremate three bodies in half an hour.

The "Selection Point"

As meticulous record keepers, the Nazis took pictures of the entire extermination process. You see here, one of their pictures. These pictures captured the transports arriving and the Jews emptying out of the railroad cars. Men and older boys were separated to one side of the platform with women and children of both sexes on the other. Every individual walked along the platform to a **place where they were examined** for just a second or two by SS officers for their fitness. Here it was determined whether they would be worked to death as slave laborers or sent directly to their deaths in the gas chambers. All the old men, most women and young children were sent directly to their deaths. That place of examination and selection for life or death is notoriously known as the "Selection Point." It was here that monsters like Dr. Joseph Mengele stood and chose the victims of their hideous medical experiments.

Visiting the "Selection Point"

The first time I stood at the "Selection Point" was in 2001. Visiting the death camps defies description. All one can do is walk around in stunned silence and witness the evidences of the horrific vicious cruelty and demonic blood lust of the Nazi regime. The camps exemplify the inhuman, insane, murderous, satanically inspired hatred that was at the heart of Nazi Germany.

I realized that I was standing at the place that was literally the **epicenter of evil**, where the Nazi's hatred perpetrated the murders of millions of Jewish people. However, it was not just German hatred. All the European nations, Russia and the Ukraine had deeply engrained anti-Semitic beliefs and long histories of persecuting the Jewish people. They all were either directly or indirectly involved, to greater or lesser degrees, in supporting **The Final Solution**. They all share the guilt of creating the "Selection Point."

In fact, the "Selection Point" was not just the epicenter of Nazi hatred and European complicity. It was the result of centuries and millennia of demonic anti-Semitic doctrines embraced by the Church and spewed forth by her deceived leaders. The "Selection Point" is the culmination and the ultimate fruit of replacement theology and all the other **teachings of contempt and hatred** toward the Jewish people from both secular and "Christian" sources.

Although there were many concentration camps, death camps and scores of massacre sites, the "Selection Point" at Birkenau is uniquely positioned to represent all those other places where the Jews were murdered. It remains exactly as it was the day it was liberated by the Russian army. Here you stand precisely where the SS officers stood as they determined the fate of every Jew they briefly examined. Here we see the evil fruit of the culmination of centuries of anti-Semitic doctrine and dogma. Here the truth is clear; here the real motive of the demonic spirit behind anti-Semitism is revealed. Anti-Semitism means death; physical death for the Jewish people and spiritual death (the "cutting off") for the Church.

Unique Invitation

I returned to Poland for several summers, teaching Jewish Roots at conferences held in different Polish cities. In July 2005, the conference was permanently moved to Oswiecim and called "From

Holocaust to Hope." Part of the agenda of the conference included taking everyone to visit the Auschwitz-Birkenau death camps. The leaders of the conference asked me to lead a **Communion Service at the "Selection Point"** in Birkenau. Years ago, the Lord had given these leaders a vision to take small groups of believers to have Communion there, but this was the first time they ever hosted such a large group. This was also the first time they ever had a Jewish believer lead it. As a Messianic Jew, I felt very honored and humbled to be chosen by the Lord to lead such a service at the very "Selection Point" of the enemy.

Leading that Communion service was one of the most profound experiences of my life. It impacted me so deeply that I could not even talk about it for three days. After that I could only speak about my experience with great difficulty. It has also been a very arduous task to write about this experience because I had a great struggle to find the words that expressed what the Lord showed me there. I pray that I am able to communicate this to you because I believe that by having Communion at the "Selection Point," we are releasing something in the realm of the Spirit that could have a major impact on the future history of the Church and its relationship to the Jewish people.

Communion at the "Selection Point"

As I began to lead the Communion service, I became intensely aware of the following three things:

- 1. Here I was, **a Jew**, standing in the place where so many Jews stood facing imminent death or merciless suffering. As all Jews who come to the camps realize, I knew that if I had been alive in that generation, I could have been standing among them.
- 2. I was standing there not only as a Jew, but as a **Jewish believer in Jesus** and an influential leader in His church.
- 3. Because of the long and painful history of Christian anti-Semitism, I was standing at a place that epitomized the complicated, convoluted deep historic and continuing conflict between **the Jewish people and Jesus Christ**. I was also acutely aware of what that relationship means for the fulfillment of Biblical prophecy which culminates in Messiah's return.

So Deeply Scarred

It is very important for you to understand how deeply the Holocaust has affected the Jewish people. It is the defining modern experience for them; every Jewish soul is scarred to one degree or another by the Holocaust. Jewish consciousness and worldview is influenced by it. It is the lens through which the Jewish people view the world. Evidence of this is the fact that virtually every Jewish publication you read has some reference to it in one way or another, either directly or indirectly. The nation of Israel was born out of the ashes of the Holocaust and its memory stands as a stark reminder for Jews in general and for Israelis in particular, of the ultimate goal of those who hate them.

My Vision

As the service continued, I lifted above my head the **Cup of Redemption** that represents the Messiah's Blood. In a very brief but extremely profound several minutes, I felt, heard and saw, in

the depths of my spirit, several parallel visions that were confluencing together as one prophetic message. With an intensity, I find hard to describe, these visions deeply affected me on every emotional, psychological and spiritual level.

The images I watched were like movie highlights from history. They were alternately depicting the glorious redemptive history of the authentic **Body of Christ** and then the **Christian Church** with its long, painful history of anti-Semitic raging against and persecutions of the Jewish people and then the deeply rooted animosity of the Jews toward Jesus, the Church and the religion of Christianity because of that painful history.

In those visions, I saw and heard anti-Semitic ranting and raving preachers stirring ignorant crowds into violent frenzies. I listened to Church leaders teaching demonic doctrines and perverted lies that bred hatred and persecution, pogroms, inquisitions, expulsions and forced conversions. All of that led to the genocide carried out in the very place we were standing. Surrounded by death, I could feel the **legacy of hatred** and the **teachings of contempt**, in the name of **Jesus Christ**, that has so deeply and profoundly scarred my Jewish people.

Stark Contrast of Repentance

Yet here we were, *repenting* for those horrendous historic sins and *renouncing* their present influences. We were doing this because we had all personally experienced the *redemption* that we were commemorating in the Communion. He, whose name was perversely used to spew forth hatred against the Jews, is the one who has changed our lives and given us His love for them and for all people.

My entire being became deeply, profoundly and painfully aware that the "Selection Point" was not just the result of the Nazi's insane hatred, but it was in fact the culmination of centuries of vitriolic hatred that the Church preached against my people. It was that satanically inspired hatred, nurtured by insidious, nefarious demonic doctrines and the evil agendas of deluded leaders which created the beliefs that ultimately birthed **The Final Solution** and enabled the creation of such a place as the "Selection Point." It represents the ultimate fruit of Christian anti-Semitism, replacement theology (the deceitful doctrine that teaches that the Church has replaced Israel in God's plan; the Jews are no longer God's chosen people and have no prophetic destiny) and all the other teachings, dogmas and ideologies that taught contempt and hatred for the Jewish people.

As I watched that horrific history of the Church unfold, my awareness of my own *Jewishness* and the fact that I, a *Jew*, was leading this Communion service, became even more powerful. Here I was, a *Jew* whose people were persecuted and murdered for the **crime of being** *Jewish*. At the same time, I was also deeply and acutely aware that I stood at this horrific place of death, not just as a *Jew*, but as a *Jewish* believer in *Jesus* who my people blame as the root cause of all **Christian anti-Semitism**. They blame *Him*; they accuse *Him* (whose name many of those who suffered and died here would not even speak) of being a heretic, an apostate, a traitor, a liar and a deceiver. *He* is the founder of the hated religion of Christianity which has caused them so much pain. *He*, the rejected and despised *Jesus Christ*, is the one who is ultimately to blame for their suffering and pain.

The Messiah

And why should the Jews believe otherwise? Their rabbis, whom they trusted implicitly, taught them that Jesus was just another false messiah, a deceiver who must be rejected and shunned. They taught that the Christians ignorantly misunderstood, misinterpreted and misapplied the Torah and Hebrew Scriptures. The Jewish experience of Christianity and the vast majority of those who called themselves Christians only proved their point. Those who claimed to represent Jesus spewed forth hatred and venom, despising them, expelling them from their homes and countries, massacring them and burning them alive in their own synagogues. The persecution was not always overt and direct, but sometimes subtle and indirect (i.e. denial of employment opportunities or university admittance). All of this has left my people in pain with lasting emotional and psychological scars.

The Vision Continued...

As the vision continued, I watched so-called "debates" forced upon the Jews by the Church. The rabbis held fast to their devotion to the Torah and their traditional interpretations of the Scriptures. They continued to proclaim their rejection of Jesus as the Messiah. That stance only confirmed the belief of the Church that the Jews were "perfidious" and therefore rejected by God and worthy of persecution and death. I saw inquisitors torturing Jews until they confessed to anything, even that Jesus was the Messiah, and then executing them anyway.

I saw the Yeshivas (Jewish schools) and Synagogues, where I heard arguments rabbis used to prove that Jesus could not be the Messiah, while at the same time forbidding the reading of the New Testament because of the **lies and hatred** they believed it taught. I could see and feel the rage of the rabbis and the Jewish people at the mere mention of the name of Jesus, and the fury of the preachers, priests and bishops toward the Jews as the "Christ Killers." Interwoven between and above all of this I could see Jesus. He whom the Jews blame as the ultimate source of their suffering is the only one who can be their ultimate source of redemption and salvation.

A Redeemed People

As these visions were exploding in my spirit, I was also profoundly aware that I was a Jew who had **personally experienced** the power of the Messiah's resurrection and redemption. This awareness was coupled with another intense flow of images. This was the positive side of the history of the Church.

The ugly sinful side of Church history began to fade and was replaced by **the beautiful**, **holy side**. I saw the untold **millions upon millions** of people down through the centuries and up to the present moment, whose lives were wonderfully transformed by the **redemptive power** of the crucified and resurrected Messiah.

Not all Christians and Church leaders through the centuries hated the Jews or persecuted them; some befriended and even at the risk of their own lives protected them. Those **true believers** carried the authentic "torch of testimony" throughout Europe and many suffered greatly for their faith. If all Christians and Church leaders everywhere had hated and persecuted the Jews incessantly, they never would have been able to live anywhere in Europe, let alone prosper in so

many countries. For example, the Jews lived and thrived in Poland for 1,000 years before the Holocaust! In fact, the Jews called Poland "Polanya," which is Hebrew for "God Dwells Here."

Power of Redemption

As I looked around at those gathered to have Communion, I saw **living proof of that redemption**. Here were people whose lives were transformed by **Jesus**, whose atoning death and justifying resurrection we were commemorating. Because they have experienced His redemption, and understood their role as priests who can make intercession for others (1 Peter 2:5, 9; Revelation 1:6), they were repenting for the sins of previous generations and interceding with tears for the present generation of Jews and Christians. Here at this place of death, stood people whose testimony is that the real Jesus - not the "Jesus" used as a tool of hatred by demonically inspired leaders - but the real Jesus, the resurrected redeemer, is the source of **life transforming healing love**.

These **precious believers** came from all over Poland, Europe, England and America to celebrate in the Communion the wonderful gift of eternal life that this Jewish Messiah had purchased for them by the shedding of his Blood and the offering of His Body as a sacrifice for their sins. They came to this place of death to proclaim the victory of the Savior over death. They came to this place of suffering to proclaim their love for the Jewish people and for the nation of Israel. They came to the "Selection Point" to make prophetic declarations about God's present purposes for the Body of Christ and the Jewish people, and to proclaim their commitment to see those purposes fulfilled.

Reconciliation

Here before me, at the "Selection Point," was clear evidence that the Lord is presently fulfilling His intention to reconcile His Church to her Jewish Roots and to the Jewish people. Here before me was proof that Jesus is **cleansing His Body** from the demonic spirit of anti-Semitism. At the "Selection Point" these precious believers were repenting for the sins of the Church toward the Jewish people and tear fully interceding for them. Only the **Prince of Life** could impart such a heart into people who, if they were not **born from above**, would simply be like everyone else. But they are not like everyone else because of what the Messiah has done in their lives. Here they were worshipping, repenting and interceding with heartfelt prayers. Here they were thanking Jesus for the **new life** He has given them and for the freedom and the forgiveness they have received. Here they were thanking Him for the Blood He shed, the Blood that provides atonement, forgiveness and personal fellowship with the God of Israel. Here they were thanking Him for the **love He has given** them for all people and especially for the Jewish people. This is what touched me most profoundly.

Messianic King

As I watched and listened to these Christians weep and pray, another vision began. I watched the story of redemption unfold. There was **Jesus**, crucified for our sins and resurrected for our redemption. I saw how **He**, who is rejected and despised by the Jewish people, is in fact their only hope. **He** is their Messianic King. Jesus, rejected by the Jews and horrendously misrepresented by

the Church, is the perfect expression of the Love of God. *He* is the Savior and Redeemer, whose life was sacrificed as the atonement for the sins of the world. Only *He* has the power to change the world because only *He* has the power to change human hearts.

A Call to the "Selection Point"

As all of this was cascading together in my mind and spirit, a new greater vision dawned, like the sun rising over the horizon, which shone down upon all that I was watching. First, I saw the map in the Auschwitz museum of all the rail lines throughout Europe converging here. Then I began to hear the Lord speak into my spirit. Even as I was listening to these words, I clearly understood it was something that only God Himself could accomplish. He said:

"Just as the devil sought to bring the Jews of Europe to this place to kill them, so I desire to bring the Body of Christ from the nations to this place to repent and be purged and cleansed from the spirit of anti-Semitism. I want them to receive fresh love for the Jewish people and a new anointing, power and understanding to fulfill My plans and purposes for the Jewish people and for the nations."

In this new vision, I watched tens of thousands of believers come from all over the world to have Communion at the "Selection Point." They were declaring the victory of Jesus over the sins of the past, over the demonic doctrines of replacement theology and anti-Semitism, over Satan's past attempts to kill all the Jewish people and his present plans to destroy the nation of Israel today. The devil brought the Jews to the "Selection Point" to kill them. The Lord wants to bring the Church to the "Selection Point" to cleanse her and fill her with healing love for the Jewish people. I watched the Body of Christ receiving new life at the place of death and fresh love at the place of hatred. I watched the place of satanic hatred and death be literally transformed into a place of God's love and life. I watched the church, once a source of evil against the Jews, be transformed into a source of love, hope and faith for them. I believe that having "Communion at the Selection Point" is a prophetic symbolic act representing what the Lord wants to do in His Body in every place. He wants to turn hatred into love and death into life.

Fresh Impartation

The vision ended with those multitudes leaving the "Selection Point" and going to the four corners of the earth with a fresh impartation, anointing and understanding of God's present prophetic purposes for the ministry of the Church in the nations and in her relationship to the Jewish people. They were leaving that place of death with new life, fresh vision and anointing to disciple the nations and be restored to their Biblical Jewish Roots and their responsibility to love unconditionally and testify uncompromisingly, in the power of the Holy Spirit, of this new life to the Jewish people. The **place of death** was transformed into a **place of life**. Love replaced hate and blessings replaced curses.

Why Communion?

Communion is a unique spiritual experience that connects us in a very tangible way with the One who offers His forgiveness and redemption to those who partake with repentance, humility, faith and obedience. It does nothing for those who partake as a mere formality or ritual. God knows the

heart and He is not fooled. He does not forgive those who believe that by merely eating and drinking some consecrated bread and wine, they receive His forgiveness, as if those elements themselves had some kind of magical abilities to impart forgiveness. God is looking for and responds to faith and obedience (Hebrews 11:6; James 2:6). Many Nazi mass murderers went to weekly Communion services thinking they were doing God's will by murdering Jews. Such people will stand before the Lord in judgment not forgiveness.

The Communion, taken not as a mere formalized ritual, but with a heart to obey and a living faith, becomes for us **supernatural food** (John 6:27-35, 48-58) that imparts the life and love of Messiah Jesus into the depths of our being. It is this life and love that turns fear into faith, despair into hope, hatred into love and death into life. Through the power of the Communion, the "Selection Point" can become a unique place where the Body of Christ can be cleansed, purged and freed from the influences of anti-Semitism and restored to her Biblical relationship and responsibility to the Jewish people. As believers leave that place with new love and power, anti-Semitism in the church can be eradicated and a new chapter in the history of the Church and the Jewish people can begin. The "Selection Point" – the place of death – can be redeemed. It can become a place of new beginnings for the Body of Christ in her relationship with the Jewish people. **The "Selection Point" was a place where Jewish lives ended; it can become a place where love for the Jewish people begins**.

Our King can point directly at His enemy and say, "You made this a place of death, but just as I triumphed over you in my death and resurrection, so I will triumph over you here. I will make this place of death into a place of life." God delights to take what Satan meant for evil and use it for good (Gen. 50:20; Rom. 8:28).

Portals of Life and Death

As human beings, we have the potential to influence the world around us either for good or evil. As beings of influence, we become doorways or portals that both God and the Devil can use to influence our world. God speaks His truths, His commandments, to influence us for good, for blessings and prosperity. Satan's lies always bring evil and destruction because "he was a murderer from the beginning" (John 8:44).

Satan uses lies to gain access to our lives. If we reject the lies, we close the door, or the portal, to Satan's influence over us. However, if we listen to those lies (and Satan does not care which lie you buy - any lie will do) and believe them, they exert a tremendous negative influence over our thoughts, feelings, words and actions. We become portals by which those lies can bring evil and destruction not only to our lives, but to every life we touch. When Adam and Eve listened to Satan's lies and disobeyed the Lord, they became a portal that allowed sin to enter into the world. This sin is seen in the story of the first murder when Cain killed Abel (Gen 4:1-16; 1 John 3:12). Humanity's spiritual enemy has continually used the same strategy; **lies**, achieving the same result, **death**.

As you study the rise of Nazism, Hitler's ascension to power and the development of the SS (who were directly responsible for carrying out "The Final Solution"), you can see how Satan used a combination of lies to accomplish his purposes. He combined lust for political power, intense racial

pride, racial hatred and deeply held occultic beliefs to make Germany the portal of death that started World War II and fueled the Jewish Holocaust. This not only affected the Jewish people but all of humanity. Over 60 million people died during the war and its ramifications continue to affect our world today.

God uses His Word, the Truth, in a similar way. He speaks to us in the Scriptures and by His Spirit. We can choose to open our heart, which is the door or the portal of our lives, to His Word and enter into an ever-deepening relationship with Him. Jesus knocks on the door of our heart (Rev. 3:20). We must open that door and receive Him in order to become one of the children of God (John 1:12). Jesus also likened Himself to a door – a portal through which we enter into the Father (John 10:9, 14:6). He also taught us that when *two or more of his disciples gathered together He would be in their midst* (Matt. 18:20). That gathering is a portal for Him to enter and manifest Himself.

A classic story in the Bible about portals is Genesis 28:12-17. Jacob had a dream in which he saw angels ascending and descending on a ladder. When he awoke, he declared that the place he was in was "the gate (Hebrew – Shahar - door or portal), of Heaven." In Hosea 2:15, God promises to "open a door of hope in the valley of trouble." In many ways Communion at the "Selection Point" is exactly that, a door of hope in the valley of trouble.

Open a Portal of Life

During these visions, I saw that the "Selection Point" was physically a place where a portal of death was opened. Once the enemy was able to get the Jews there, he could send them directly to the gas chambers. I understood that the Lord wanted to close that portal of death and open a portal of life at that very place.

I was stunned by this concept and the startling contrast: this horrific place of death transformed into a place of life! The very place where the devil killed Jewish people transformed into a place where the love of God for the Jewish people could be imparted to the Body of Christ.

Redeem the Holocaust

Later in the evening as I meditated over all I experienced that day, I heard the Lord say, "I intend to redeem the Holocaust." When I heard this, I was even more astounded. I said to Him, "How do you do that? You cannot change history. How do you heal this wound that goes beyond description and understanding? How do you redeem this horror?" He gave me a very simple and deeply profound answer, "One Heart at a Time."

Hallelujah! Only God can do such things! Only God can fulfill it. Only He can bring redemption out of this massive evil. Only He can bring healing into such pain. **Only He can open a portal of love and life at the place of hatred and death**. Only God can impart love for the Jewish people into the Body of Christ. Only God can give a revelation to His Church of her Biblical relationship and responsibility to the Jewish people. No preacher or teacher, prophet or apostle can do this. It is purely a work of the living God Himself! Amen.

Invitation to the "Selection Point"

The vision for Communion at the "Selection Point" can be summed up this way; Satan brought the Jews to the "Selection Point" to kill them; God wants to bring His Church to the "Selection Point" to fill them with life giving love for the Jews. By coming in humility and repentance to the "Selection Point" and sharing in Communion, the Church can be delivered from the spirit of anti-Semitism and filled with love for the Jewish people. As the Church receives Communion and *Repents* for her historic sins against the Jewish people, she can then *Renounce* them so that they no longer have any place in the life or teaching of the Church. The Communion can then become a way by which the Church will *Receive* a fresh impartation of love for the Jewish people and new anointing to enable her to demonstrate that love to them and to the nations of the world.

Please understand that the Communion service at the "Selection Point" is no triumphalist Christian ceremony to show the superiority of Christianity over Judaism, nor is it an attempt to diminish or minimize what happened there – God forbid. Thoughts like that would be a demonic perversion of this vision. Auschwitz will always be a place of horror and mourning. This prophetic vision is about the Body of Christ coming to this place of pain for the Jewish people and identifying with them in humility and repentance for its history of anti-Semitism. This is about the Body of Christ coming to this place of death to declare in the Communion the victory of the Messiah over sin and death, and to prophetically proclaim that God's purposes for the Church and for the Jewish people will be fulfilled.

I believe that God is going to put into the heart of members of the Body of Christ throughout the world to receive Communion at the "Selection Point" at least once in their life. As they do, they will be able to enter into a new level of participation in the Lord's present prophetic purposes for the Church and the Jewish people because they will leave the "Selection Point" with a new heart for the Jewish people.

Can anti-Semitism be completely removed from the world? Not until the Lord returns. But we can work with His Holy Spirit to remove anti-Semitism from the Body of Christ around the world one heart at a time.

What Can You Do?

We ask that you prayerfully consider what God is calling you to do, now that you have been made aware of this opportunity to redeem the Holocaust. Help me make this vision known to the Body of Christ. Pray for us and help support this end time prophetic work with your financial gifts.
